



• In case of DISTRESS – do whatever necessary to save yourself, (your crew) – and your vessel.

"Emergency overrules everything"



Crossing of Route T


• Be aware of vessels in Route T at any time when crossing.

Vessels with a draught of up till 15-16 meters and a length of up till 400meters.

 If you are less than 1 NM to their bow – you are almost invisible ("depending")



TSS East bridge




No boats in TSS unless distress

 Passage between pylon and anchor block OR closer to land

(Never – <u>ever</u> – opposite direction)


TSS East bridge



Small protection islands


 Check water depth before passing other side spans

West bridge




• Respect 500m & direction (if using main lanes)

TSS Hatter



- Most interesting for RED Course
- Do <u>NOT</u> enter Traffic separation zone unless distress
- Do not use the TSS & DW
- Røsnæs to Sejerø
- Beware of high speed ferries (Sj.Odde)







Key Points Exclusion Zone Bridge







Shortening



Shortening – reduced course
