## **1. RULES**

### **1.1**

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the statutes for Danish Championships in sailing, the Nordic Sailing Federations, and the regulations of the Danish Sailing Association.

### **1.2**

The races will be conducted under DH 2024 - the boats' GPH ratings will be used to calculate final sailing time and ranking.

Additionally, the following rules apply: Safety and equipment instructions for the Danish Singlehand Championships.

### **1.3**

The rules are amended as follows:

- **RRS 44.1** is amended so that the two-turn penalty is replaced with a one-turn penalty.
- **RRS 60.1(a)** is amended so that a boat cannot protest against certain parts of the sailing instructions.
- **RRS 62.1(a)** is amended so that a boat cannot protest/request redress concerning certain parts of the sailing instructions.
- **RRS A4 and A5.1** are amended so that boats that start later than four minutes after the start signal are marked "Did Not Start" without a hearing.

The sailing instructions may also change other Racing Rules of Sailing.

## **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

### **2.1**

The sailing instructions will be available on Manage2sail from August 23, 2024.

## **3. COMMUNICATION**

### **3.1**

The official notice board is located at Vejerboden, and announcements will also be displayed on the notice board at [vegvisirrace.com](http://vegvisirrace.com).

### 3.2

When a boat is racing, it may neither send nor receive voice or data signals that are not available to all boats, except in an emergency.

### 3.3

The race committee will use VHF radio Channel 72 in certain situations to communicate with participants. Therefore, it is recommended to carry a VHF radio. [DP]

## 4. PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION

### 4.1

The event is open to the following boat classes: Boats with a valid DH measurement certificate.

### 4.2

Boats that meet the requirements for participation can register for the event no later than August 26, 2024.

From now until 26/8, registration must be made to the race director Carsten Berntsen, phone +45 40402577.

### 4.3

To be registered for the event, a boat must have completed all registration requirements and paid all fees.

## 6. ADVERTISING

### 6.1

Boats may be required to display advertisements selected and provided by the organizing authority. [DP]

## 7. SCHEDULE

### 7.1

#### **Registration:**

Registration must take place on Wednesday, August 28, between 14:00 - 20:00. All boats must be registered before the warning signal for the first race in which the boat participates.

- **Thursday, August 29, 2024**  
DH Class - Up/Down Course - 2 races
- **Friday, August 30, 2024**  
DH Class - Up/Down Course, and Distance Race "Vegvisir Race Nyborg - 90 nautical miles, Blue Course" - 2 races and start of the distance race

### **7.3**

The warning signal for the first race each day is scheduled for 08:55 for the course races.

### **7.4**

On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be given later than 12:00 for the course races.

## **8. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION / SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

### **8.1**

Safety check from 15:00-18:00 on August 28.

## **9. LOCATION**

### **9.1**

The event will be conducted from Nyborg Marina, Vesterhavnen / Østerhavnen.

### **9.2**

The course is located in Nyborg Fjord / Great Belt.

## **10. COURSES**

### **10.1**

The course races will be held on an up/down course in Nyborg Fjord.

The distance race, described under Vegvisirrace, Blue Course 90 nautical miles, starts from the start area in Nyborg Fjord and continues into the Great Belt.

## **11. PENALTY SYSTEMS**

### **11.1**

**RRS 44.1** is amended so that the two-turn penalty is replaced with a one-turn penalty.

## **12. SCORING**

### **12.1**

4 races are required to constitute the championship.

## **15. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

### **15.1**

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the event except with the prior written permission of the race committee and according to its terms. [DP]

## **16. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**

### **16.1**

Diving equipment, plastic pools, and similar equipment shall not be used around keelboats after the preparatory signal for the first race until after the last race. [DP]

## **18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

### **18.1**

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. (See RRS 3, Decision to Race.) The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

## **19. SAFETY**

### **19.1**

**RRS 40.1** applies from the time the boat leaves the dock until it returns to the dock: All participants must wear personal flotation devices, except when briefly changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wetsuits and drysuits are not considered personal flotation devices.

## **20. INSURANCE**

### **20.1**

Each participating boat shall be covered by valid third-party liability insurance.

## **21. PRIZES**

### **21.1**

The following prizes will be awarded: Official DS medals to the top 3 boats.
